4. Cancellation Policy

- If the Artist cancels for any reason other than non-payment of balance or Presenter's breach of this Agreement, then the Deposit will be refunded in full.
- If the Presenter or Venue cancels for any reason, the Artist will retain the Deposit.
- In the event of cancellation by either party, neither the Artist nor Presenter/Venue will be held liable for any additional damages or costs, material or immaterial, beyond the Deposit.

5. Transportation & Lodging

- a. Parking: For events within 200 miles of New York City, Presenter/Venue will provide parking for the Artist within 5 minutes walking distance of the venue.
- b. Flights & Ground Transport: For events over 200 miles from NYC, Presenter/Venue will provide round-trip flights and ground transportation to/from the nearest airport.
- c. Hotel: For events over 50 miles from NYC, Presenter/Venue will provide Artist with a hotel room of minimum 3-star rating.
- d. Travel Buyout: May be negotiated based on current flight and hotel rates in lieu of above.

6. Hospitality

- a. Private Area: Required near DJ booth; must include bathroom, electrical outlet, mirror, lighting, soap, and paper towels
- b. Bar/Catering: 4 cans tonic water, 4 cans sugar-free Red Bull, 2 clean glasses, bucket of ice
- c. Meal: Most cuisines acceptable; basic meats and vegetables preferred; no fried food
- d. Meal Buyout: \$50 may be substituted for meal

7. Technical

- a. Venue Gear: 2–3 Pioneer CDJ-3000 or CDJ-2000NXS2 decks, 1 Pioneer DJM-A9 or DJM-900NXS2 mixer, all connected via network switch with one open port
- b. Artist Gear: 2 USB drives, 1–2 keytars, 1 computer (connected to Channel 1 RCA inputs)

8. Liability & Insurance

Presenter/Venue is responsible for ensuring a safe performance environment. The Artist is not liable for any injuries, equipment damage, or incidents occurring on-site unless due to gross negligence by the Artist.

9. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform due to acts of God, government restrictions, natural disasters, or other unforeseeable events beyond reasonable control. In such cases, both parties will attempt in good faith to reschedule.

10. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, and any disputes shall be resolved in the courts of Morris County, NJ, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.
